



3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members





92 articles were published in 2017.


Number of articles has been increasing every year.

5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2017




In 2017, HBSN has published **92 papers**, among which there are **24** review articles and original articles.

6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2017





9. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2017




The total retrieval of HBSN in PubMed is **193,418** times in 2017.
